



Interior Fire Attack - 4-8 hrs.



The ability to confine and extinguish the modern fire is the benchmark of a good engine company. This class will use classroom as well as hands on instruction to reinforce interior attack fundamentals as well as advanced topics involving scene size up, positioning the attack line, advancing the attack line, coordinated ventilation, reading smoke, and interior safety principles. The classroom portion will utilize video scenarios for classroom discussion of current tactics. Classroom portions of this class will also cover the explanation of tactics derived from the recent UL and NIST studies. The BullEx digital fire attack simulator will be used during the hands on portion of the class.

This class can also be tailored to fit your specific departmental needs to include Primary Search, VES, and SCBA confidence course.

Host Responsibilities:

- ❖ Minimum 12 students.
- ❖ SCBA refill capability.
- ❖ Rehab (cases of water).

Minimum Student Requirements

- ❖ Full PPE
- ❖ Working knowledge of Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA).
- ❖ Clean shaven. Clean shaven means no facial hair is present where the seal of the air mask comes into contact with your face. Live Fire Instructors have been instructed to not allow students to participate in live fire classes who do not meet this clean-shaven definition above.
